



What is Virginia SUN Bucks?

Virginia is working with the United States
Department of Agriculture (USDA) to pilot a new
program called Virginia SUN Bucks. Through
Virginia SUN Bucks, some families will receive extra
money to help with the costs of groceries.





Each school–aged child that meets the program requirements will get a

one-time payment of \$120

Benefits

Benefits will be loaded onto existing SNAP recipients' EBT cards while others will receive a new Virginia SUN Bucks card in the mail.





Good News!

The good news is many families automatically qualify for Virginia SUN Bucks and will not need to take any steps to receive this new benefit!

Who is automatically eligible for Virginia SUN Bucks and does not need to apply?

Your child is automatically enrolled in Virginia SUN Bucks if they:

Receive Supplemental Nutrition
Assistance Program (SNAP) or
Temporary Assistance for
Needy Families (TANF) benefits
or participate in an income-based
Medical Assistance Program.

Applied for and received free or reduced-price meals at school during the 2023–2024 school year.

How do I know if my family needs to apply for Virginia SUN Bucks?

You must apply for Virginia SUN
Bucks if your child did not apply for
and receive free or reduced-price
school meals or your family does
not participate in SNAP, TANF or an
income-based Medical Assistance
Program. Some schools provide free
meals to kids without an application.

If your child attends one of these schools and they do not participate in SNAP, TANF or an income-based Medical Assistance Program, you should apply!
